Treasurer's Report for Committee Meeting 25th July 2024

Since my last report:

Three away matches, two of which were on budget. The match against the Ladies shows a £40 shortfall due to the Burford captain being in our team as our guest.

Two home matches:

Dorset -£17 worse than budget Berkshire - £164 better than budget, with the catering cost being £5 per head lower than both last year's North Oxford charge and forecast.

Four events:

Spring Meeting - £89 adverse, due to the unbudgeted £100 room hire

President's Cup – A huge £319 improvement over budget. Catering was only £28 per head – last year Taddy charged £35.

Mixed Greensomes- £17 up Four Counties - £241 better than budget. Once again, catering was only £28.50 per head against a budget of £34. I feel I overcooked the budget here (geddit?)! Also, Ray managed to save £58 on prizes and £51 on wine.

As can be seen, overall we are £594 ahead of budget, so the year should be good, as will cashflow.

I do have some concerns however:

- The attendance at our events is generally poor compared with history
- 2. Clothing sales are slow. We currently have over £600 worth of jumpers and slip-overs in stock. Whether we ever sell them all, given the known quality issues is worrying.


Craig Breeze is copied in so that he may please reassure the Henley Past Captains that their OGC membership is still secure for life.

Dear James,

It is with the greatest sadness that recently we learnt that you have effectively, by intending to charge the Oxfordshire Golf Captains (OGC) green fees, decided to withdraw from the jointly beneficial agreement that was struck between your club and our association some 56 years ago.

That agreement was simply that you would provide us with the benefit of courtesy of the course for not more than one event each year, or put another way, between 60 and 90 minutes of tee-times per year; the quid pro quo for this courtesy would be that your Captains would be entitled to become lifetime members of the OGC.

The benefits that fall from our partnership are not all one-sided. Our accounts show that catering, bar and other purchases total between £1,200 and £1,750 per match; of course, we accept that whatever profit stems from those sums will depend on the financial management and efficacy of the club, but they should not be inconsiderable.

We consider it fair to point out that our members pay for their guests at home matches and your new policy would now more than double their match fee, possibly to between £100 and £120 at Henley; this is clearly unsustainable. Because of this, the OGC have decided, with great reluctance and even greater sadness, that we too will have to withdraw from the erstwhile happy arrangement with your Club.

Currently, Henley Golf Club has 26 Past Captains who are members of the OGC and their membership will not be affected by your decision. However, your future Captains from 2025 will not be eligible to join and they are the real losers in all this. Just about every County in England has an association of Past Golf Club Captains and membership has always been seen as a just and deserving reward for all of the time, work and expense every Captain lavishes on his club during his year in office; we fear you are now denying your own Captains this small token of gratitude.

In the meantime, it's sad to reflect that the happy occasion of our match against the Devon Golf Captains two months ago might well be the final time that we all will enjoy such convivial events together. Additionally, we also have to confirm that the agreed reservation for our Mixed Invitation event on Monday, 7th July next year, will now also have to be cancelled.
