#### MINUTES OF COMMITTEE MEETING

#### 1. Attendance

#### 2. Previous Minutes -

- a) Committee Meeting 12<sup>th</sup> April 2023
   Minutes of the previous Committee Meeting were Approved and duly signed by the Captain.
- b) Matters Arising
  - i) Committee Meeting 31st August 2022.

(10.c) Keith Henley and Terry Killick were assigned the responsibility for defining the strategy and executing the utilisation of OneDrive for storage of data held by Officers with access for other Officers when necessary (e.g. incapacitation of an Officer).

At the meeting Keith and Terry advised that they think OneDrive is suitable for this purpose and that initially there is likely to be no cost for its use (i.e. free space provided will be adequate). Thereafter a cost of up to £80/year could be incurred. The meeting reminded Keith and Terry that an OGC folder already existed and that they should review that for suitability as a foundation for their development. - ii) Committee Meeting 12 April 2023.
  - (5.a.) Consider amalgamation of the Founder's Cup competition with another OGC event in 2024. It was agreed that action on this matter is left in abeyance until such time as the availability of venues is reduced to a level that cannot accommodate our current programme of fixtures. (Closed)
  - (10.a) Inform GCC of OGC's acceptance of joint funding of the offered GGC/OGC Match Trophy and advise an OGC Member name to appear on the Trophy.

This matter was concluded on 13 May 2023 with Derek Honey's name to be added. (Closed)

(10.c) Further advice on ongoing discussions with Tadmarton Management regarding "courtesy of the course" for OGC events 2023/24

Tim Nunneley advised the Committee that satisfactory discussions had been held with Tadmarton GC Management and agreement to the affirmative had been reached. (Closed)

(10.e) Seek a replacement for (or encourage to continue), Roger Sillence as Match Secretary, in response to his announced that he intended not to stand for re-election as Match Secretary for 2024.

Roger and Ian Allison advised that they had had initial discussion about how the handover to a prospective candidate for the replacement Match Secretary could be established. Bill White suggested that, as Roger had offered to retain some of his current duties/responsibilities, it may be feasible to split the role in a manner akin to that applied to the Secretary and Events Secretary (e.g. the management of inter county matches separated from annual overall fixture arrangement and tours, etc.). After some discussion, it was agreed that such a split should be defined for further discussion and that thereafter an invitation for candidates for the resultant vacant position (for 2024), would be circulated to Members. ### Treasurer's Report for Committee Meeting 13th June 2023

113 subs so far – last year 120 at this stage. Five new members – last year **eleven**.

The Spring meeting was, of course, affected by weather and a buggy ban. A £70 saving was made on gratuities, as the buffet-style dinner required few staff and numbers were low. A £27 overall saving on budget was a good result.

The match at home to Worcestershire was £188 worse than budget — Henley catering costs were £37 per head (budget £31). The Sussex match at Studley was £159 better than budget as 2 players did not stop for dinner and — unusually — we were not charged for them.

Away matches are £22 worse than budget. We were one short for the Cambridge match, but the Captain did not play so £15 discount did not apply.

Sundry items include £60 for the Gloucestershire match trophy.

Whilst we currently have plenty of cash, my forecasts required me to withdraw £500 from the deposit account (101 days' notice required)
